Session description (maxiumum 150 words) *
Descriptions should speak directly to what makes your session interesting to the library sector - what are you talking about that people need to hear? How will this information make a difference to someone's work? What does this session mean within the sector at large?
 Avoid generalizations and filler words. Be specific, be concise. Sell your session! You've done important work, necessary work, work that makes your system and the sector better. So tell us about that, and more importantly, show us how we can achieve that work ourselves.
OLA retains the right to modify titles and descriptions for brevity and clarity.


